Pursuant to General Statutes of North Carolina Section 143-131 as amended, bids will be received by the Chemical Hygiene Office for Cumberland County Schools for the following:

The County plans to contract for Hazardous Chemical Disposal in school buildings in Cumberland County Schools. All bids submitted must meet or exceed the specifications as outlined in this REQUEST FOR BIDS.

Submission of any bid signifies the Vendor's agreement that its' bid and the content thereof are valid for 90 calendar days following the submission deadline and will become part of the contract that is negotiated between Cumberland County Schools and the successful vendor. All prices submitted with the bid shall remain in effect for the 90-day period.

All bids are confidential and will not become public knowledge until opened. Cumberland County Schools reserves the right to award and/or reject any and/or all bids and waive any technicalities or irregularities. This contract will not be awarded solely on the basis of cost. Rather the contract for this project will be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance, and references.

SECTION I – INTENT of RFB and INTRODUCTION:

Intent of this RFB:

The purpose and intent of this Request for Bids is to obtain pricing Hazardous Chemical Disposal in the various schools throughout the County. It is the full responsibility of the vendor to thoroughly investigate the needs/requirements of the County, not necessarily specified in this RFB, before submitting a bid. It is the intent of the Cumberland County Schools (CCS) to award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible vendor. The CCS reserves the right to determine the lowest responsive and responsible vendor on the basis of an individual item, group of items, or any way determined to be in the best interest of CCS.

Limitations:

Service must be completed during normal hours of operation which are 7:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday thru Friday. Contractor shall make every effort to complete this work between August 8, 2017 and August 25, 2017. There shall be no interruption to the instructional day during inspection and/or testing of the fire safety systems at any location where school is in session.

Request for Clarification:

CCS will not be bound by or be responsible for any interpretations or conclusions drawn from this RFB. All questions or requests for clarification or additional information must be submitted in writing no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, July 21, 2017. These written questions or requests must be submitted to Scott Grumelot (scottgrumelot@ccs.k12.nc.us or fax (910) 678-2666). Signed faxed messages will be treated as written questions. Any questions the CCS feels are pertinent to all interested bidders will be posted on the CCS website, www.ccs.k12.nc.us, as addenda to the RFB. Any information given verbally by any CCS employee shall not be considered binding. In no event may a vendor rely on any oral statement or communication by the CCS or its' agents, advisors or consultants.

Addenda:

Any addendum to these documents shall be posted on the CCS website at www.ccs.k12.nc.us and can be found by following the "Bid Links" links. Once any addendum is posted it becomes part of this RFB and the contract. No oral statements, explanations, or commitments by anyone shall be of any effect unless incorporated into the addenda. It is the responsibility of the Vendor to periodically check the County's website to obtain any addenda that has been issued prior to submitting a bid. No addenda shall be posted after Friday, July 15, 2017 at 5:00 P.M.

SECTION II -- GENERAL CONDITIONS and FINANCIAL PROVISIONS:

BIDDER QUALIFICATION: The Contractor shall be in the business of Hazardous Chemical Disposal for a minimum of five years and be able to list a minimum (1) project of similar size and scope performed within the last three years. Reference should include project point of contact, and information for contacting.

TERMS OF CONTRACT: The initial contract term will be from August 8, 2018 and continue through August 25, 2017.

HOURS: Hazardous Chemical Disposal pickups shall be performed between 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Thursday, and some Fridays 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.

SIGNED BID CONSIDERED AN OFFER: Receipt of a signed bid shall be considered an offer on the part of the Contractor. The terms, conditions and specifications of this Request for Bids will become part of the contract if the bid shall be deemed approved and accepted by CCS. In the event of a default on the part of the Contractor after acceptance by the CCS, the CCS may take such action as it deems appropriate including legal action for damages or specific performance.

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT: The attached Iran Divestment Act must accompany the BID to be considered valid.

CONTRACT AGREEMENT: All subsequent contract agreements as a result of an award hereunder, shall incorporate all terms, conditions, and specifications contained herein, and in response hereto, unless mutually amended in writing.

ASSIGNMENT: The Contractor shall not have the right or power to assign, subcontract, or transfer interest in this contract. The Contractor is prohibited from subcontracting any services covered in the scope of work.

CHANGES: CCS shall have the right, at any time, to alter the specifications to meet increased or decreased needs. If any such changes cause an increase or decrease in the cost or the time required for the performance, or otherwise affects any other provision of this agreement, an equitable adjustment shall be made and this agreement shall be modified in writing accordingly.

AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS: Any and all payments to the Bidder shall be deemed binding only to the extent of appropriated funds for the purpose set forth in this RFB.

NON-DISCRIMINATION: The Contractor shall not discriminate against any individuals and will take proactive measures to assure compliance with all Federal and State requirements concerning fair employment, employment of people with disabilities, and concerning the treatment of all employees without regard to discrimination based upon age, race, color, religion, sex, national origin or disability.

GOVERNING LAWS: This contract is made under and shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of North Carolina.

ADVERTISING: In submitting a bid to CCS, the Contractor agrees not to use the results of their bid as a part of any commercial advertising without prior approval of CCS.

INSURANCE COVERAGE: During the term of the contract, the Contractor at their sole cost and expense shall provide commercial insurance of such type and with such terms and limits as may be reasonably associated with the contract. At a minimum, the Contractor shall provide and maintain the following coverage and limits:

- A. Workman's Compensation Statutory
Employers Liability \$500,000
- B. General Liability (per person/per occurrence):
 - 1. Bodily and Personal Liability \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000
 - 2. Property Damage \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 Aggregate
- C. Automobile Liability (per person/per occurrence)
 - 1. Bodily Injury \$1,000,000
 - 2. Property Damage: \$1,000,000 Aggregate

Certificates of Insurance shall be filed with the Owner. During construction of the work, the Contractor shall provide updated records whenever any of these coverages become outdated.

Each Certificate of Insurance shall bear the provision that the policy cannot be canceled, or coverage reduced or eliminated in less than thirty (30) days after mailing notice to the insured and/or the Owner of such alteration or cancellation. The certificate holder shall be named Attn: Tim Kinlaw, Cumberland County Board of Education, P.O. Box 2357, Fayetteville, 28302.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS: Providing and maintaining adequate insurance coverage is a material obligation of the Contractor and is of the essence of this contract. All such insurance shall meet all laws of the State of North Carolina. Such insurance coverage shall be obtained from companies that are authorized to provide such coverage and that are authorized by the Commissioner of Insurance to do business in North Carolina. The Contractor shall at all times comply with the terms of such insurance policies, and all requirements of the insurer under any such insurance policies, except as they may conflict with existing North Carolina laws or this contract. The limits of coverage under each insurance policy maintained by the Contractor shall not be interpreted as limiting the Contractor's liability and obligations under the contract. Contractor shall submit prior to award of contract Certificates of Insurance for their Worker's Compensation and General Liability Insurance which outlines comprehensive, liability, and bodily injury coverage for each accident and person. CCS will be added as an additional insured to include the endorsement form number.

COLLUSIVE BIDDING: The vendor's signature on the Cumberland County Schools "Request for Bids (RFB)" is a guarantee that the prices quoted have been arrived at without collusion with other eligible bidders and without effort to preclude Cumberland County Schools from obtaining the lowest possible competitive price.

GENERAL INDEMNITY: The Contractor shall save and hold harmless, pay on behalf of, protect, defend, and indemnify CCS (including the Superintendent, the Board of Education, as well as CCS officers, agents, and employees) from and against any demand, claim, suit, loss, expense, or damage which may be asserted against any of them in their official or individual capacities by reason of any alleged damage to property, or injury to, or death of any person arising out of, or in any way related to, any action or inaction of the Contractor (including its officers, agents, and employees) in the performance or intended performance of this agreement, or the maintenance of any facility, or the operation of any program, which is the subject of, or is related to the performance of this agreement. The obligations of the Contractor pursuant to this paragraph shall not be limited in any way by any limitation in the amount or type of proceeds, damages, compensation, or benefits payable under any policy of insurance or self-insurance maintained by or for the use and benefit of the Contractor.

TERMINATION FOR CAUSE: CCS reserves the right to terminate this contract at anytime for cause. The violation of any provision or condition contained in this contract, or the refusal, failure, or inability to carry out any provisions of this contract shall constitute sufficient cause to terminate this contract for cause. Should CCS elect to terminate this contract for cause, CCS will notify the Contractor in writing and shall specify the cause for termination and the date that such termination shall be effective. Immediate dismissals may be executed if deemed necessary by CCS.

TERMINATION WITHOUT CAUSE: CCS and the Contractor may terminate this contract without cause. Written notice of termination must be sent via certified U.S. mail no later than thirty (30) days before termination date.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST: All bidders must disclose in writing with their bid the name of any owner, officer, director, or agent who is also an employee of CCS. All bidders must also disclose in writing with their bid the name of any employee of CCS who owns, directly or indirectly, an interest of five percent (5%) or more in the bidder's firm or any of its branches or subsidiaries. By submitting a BID, the Contractor certifies that there is no relationship between the Contractor and any person or entity which is or gives the appearance of a conflict of interest related to this RFB or project.

ERRORS AND OMISSIONS: The bidder shall not take advantage of any errors or omissions in this RFB, and shall promptly notify CCS of any omissions or errors found in this document.

EVALUATION CRITERIA: CCS, at its sole discretion, following an objective evaluation, will award this contract to the most responsible, responsive bidder. Price will be a major consideration but will not be the determining factor in our selection. The bids will be evaluated on a "best overall value" basis including but not limited to pricing, quality, Contractors ability to follow the specifications, Contractors ability to provide a team of skilled, trained employees, and the Contractors experience with similar projects. CCS reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, and to waive any irregularities as may be permitted by law.

SECTION III – IDENTIFICATION and EMPLOYEE

GUIDELINES :

IDENTIFICATION: Identification badges or proper ID shall be furnished by the Contractor to all of their employees. Identification badges or ID must be clearly visible and worn by all Contractor employees while on County property.

AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL: Only authorized Contractor employees are allowed in CCS buildings. Contractor employees are not to be accompanied in the work area by acquaintances, family members, associates or any other person who is not a current, authorized employee of the Contractor.

DRUG POLICY: Contractor certifies that it maintains a drug free work place environment to ensure worker safety and workplace integrity. Contractor further agrees their employees shall comply with the CCS Drug-Free Workplace Policy.

SMOKING: Smoking is strictly prohibited on CCS property.

EMPLOYEE GUIDELINES:

- A. The Contractor shall use only qualified personnel to provide required services.
- B. Contractor shall be responsible for insuring that employees abide by all rules and regulations set forth for the buildings.
- C. Contractor shall instruct their employees not to disturb CCS students or employees beyond that which is absolutely necessary to perform the needed inspections, maintenance or testing.
- D. Personal use of CCS telephones is strictly prohibited for any purpose other than a local emergency call.
- E. Contractor employees must wear safety shoes and goggles when circumstances warrant.

SECTION IV -- SCOPE OF WORK:

OSHA: The Contractor must follow all OSHA Guidelines. The Contractor shall be responsible for any and all OSHA violations or citations as well as any fees, fines or penalties that may result from the OSHA violations or citations issued.

LOCATIONS: All locations listed in this RFB will be included in this contract for Hazardous Chemical Disposal. The CCS reserves the right to add or delete locations and equipment as needed or required, as required in the future.

LICENSED: The successful Contractor must be licensed to perform services on-site for Hazardous Chemical Disposal.

WORK: All work shall be performed on the premises of CCS. Service Provider shall remove all hazardous chemicals listed on the Hazardous Chemical Disposal form provided for the bid.

SECTION V -- PRICING and INVOICING:

PRICING: The Contractor warrants that the pricing stated herein shall remain firm for a period of one (1) year from the first day of the contract period. Pricing shall include all charges that may be imposed in fulfilling the terms of the contract.

PRICE ADJUSTMENT: After the first year, a price adjustment for recharges and parts may be passed to the CCS, upward or downward, at the beginning of each renewable fiscal year. This

will be allowed only as a result of labor or material price increase/decrease to the Contractor. The CCS shall receive full proportionate benefit of any decrease during the contract period.

NOTIFICATION OF PRICE ADJUSTMENT: The CCS Chemical Hygiene Officer must be notified in writing thirty (30) days prior to any proposed price adjustment (30 days prior to the beginning of a new fiscal year). The original quoted prices shall remain in effect until a request for price adjustment is received and approved by CCS. A copy of the manufacturer’s official notice or other evidence that the price change is general in nature shall accompany such notification.

INVOICING: The Contractor shall invoice the CCS for services performed within thirty days. All invoices shall be mailed to:

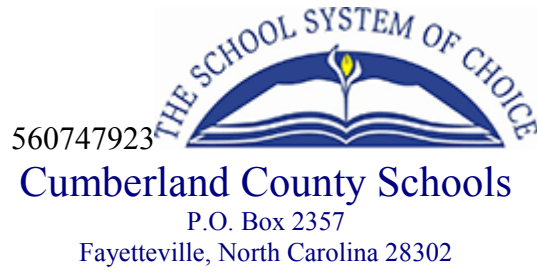
